Excerpt Certificate

Application guidelines

- Is a written extract from an existing and valid OEKO-TEX® STANDARD 100 certificate that
 corresponds to the content of the article text of the original certificate
- Issued for specific articles or order numbers that belong to a larger certified article group (the
 original certificate)
- In order to issue an excerpt, the articles must be **fully covered by the original certificate**. If the articles are not covered by the original certificate, an extension of the article group is required before an excerpt certificate can be issued
- Excerpts cannot be renewed or expanded, it is based on the details of the original certificate
- An excerpt cannot be used as a basic certificate for a certification



Case study - initial situation

A clothing company for baby and toddler articles has an OEKO-TEX® STANDARD 100 certificate (see *example for readymade clothing*). For resale to a retailer, proof is required confirming that the material, colour, print and accessories of the articles are covered by the OEKO-TEX® STANDARD 100 certificate.

The company applies to its OEKO-TEX® Institute for an excerpt certificate for this purpose. This clearly and concisely specifies that the desired articles are certified. The certificate is presented to the retailer in order to fulfil their quality requirements and create trust in the products.

Example for ready-made clothing

Article group text Original certificate:




